

## From The Pastor



With these words, this coming Wednesday we will be signed with Blessed Ashes and will be called, both collectively and individually, to forty days of prayer and penance. We are called to spiritual growth by three spiritual practices during Lent: **prayer**, **penance**, **and almsgiving**.

There is value to the discipline of giving up things we like for Lent. Maybe this year we should focus on giving up things that we want to give up for good. After all, following Lent, we will eat chocolate again, and we will drink coffee and alcohol again. What about giving up gossiping, talking about or bullying others? We can use Lent to build up good habits that we want to acquire, like being polite in traffic, taking time to visit a homebound friend, or being pleasant to people whom we tend to find irritating. Sometimes that is enough of a penance!!!

Lent is known as a time of reconciliation. We can give up grudges or anger. We can write a note to someone from whom we have been estranged. We can call and apologize to someone whom we may have offended.

Make a good Examination of Conscience and be sure to make a good confession at the beginning of Lent. At the end of Lent, after your prayer routine of 40 Days, you may desire to make another confession.

Many people observe the season by attending daily Mass, or by adding extra prayers during the day. Why not join us each weekday for Rosary and Mass? Perhaps you will consider the daily recitation of the Rosary or the reading of Sacred Scripture as a family. Why not make a weekly silent Holy Hour in church? And the devotion of the Stations of the Cross in private

or with the parish community on Fridays is one of the best Lenten practices.

An excellent opportunity for almsgiving is available through the use of the Saint Vincent de Paul Society Poor Box in the entryway of most churches. All offerings will aid the charitable works of the Saint Vincent de Paul Society to those in need.

And be sure to consider fasting and abstinence beyond the minimal requirements enjoined by the Church!

### Fasting and Abstinence

Please note that Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are both days of fasting and abstinence. Each Friday of Lent is to be observed as a day of abstinence. The law of fasting allows only one full meal and two smaller ones with no food in between. The law of abstinence forbids the eating of any meat products. The obligation of abstinence begins at age 14 and the law of fasting is binding on all Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59. Additionally, all Catholics are encouraged to do acts of penance beyond those prescribed by the law. Further, it is the responsibility of parents to see to it that their children are educated in the authentic sense of penance and are encouraged to do acts of prayer, fasting and almsgiving throughout the Lenten season.

# Pope Benedict XIV (d. 1758) on the Spiritual Meaning of Lent:

"The observance of Lent is the very badge of Christian warfare. By it we prove ourselves not to be enemies of Christ. By it we avert the scourges of divine justice. By it we gain strength against the princes of darkness, for it shields us with heavenly help. Should men grow remiss in their observance of Lent, it would be a detriment to

God's glory, a disgrace to the Catholic religion, and a danger to Christian souls.

Neither can it be doubted that such negligence would become the source of misery to the world, of public calamity, and of private woe."




