



From The Pastor



Recovering our Baptismal Dignity

As we all know, the purpose of Lent is to prepare us interiorly for the celebration of our Lord's Passion, Death and Resurrection at Easter. The goal of the Church in this holy season is to lead us to conversion and repentance, by reordering our priorities and, if necessary, changing our values and ambitions through prayer, fasting and increased acts of mercy.

Since it is by virtue of our Baptism that we already share in the Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ, the Scripture readings for Mass all refer in one way or another to Baptism.

For example, the first reading (GN 9:8-15) reminds us of how man broke the original covenant God had forged with Adam and Eve, and how He selected Noah to renew the covenant. Noah's rescue from the flood symbolizes how we are saved through the waters of Baptism, which cleanse us from sin and unite us to Christ.

In the second reading (1 PT 3:18-22), Saint Peter explicitly shows us how the episode with Noah foreshadows the Sacrament of Baptism, and he reminds us that just as Noah and his family were saved from the waters of the flood, so we are saved through Baptism: "This prefigured baptism, which saves you now."

Finally, in the Gospel (MK 1:12-15), we are told how immediately following His Baptism, Jesus was driven by the Spirit into the desert to be tempted by Satan and, having emerged successfully from that Spiritual Warfare, returned to Galilee and began preaching His Messianic mission: "This is the time of fulfillment. The Kingdom of God is at hand."

In essence, Lent is a time for all of us to recover our Baptismal dignity by imitating the example of Christ in the desert.

Accompanied by the Holy Spirit, Jesus conquered his tempter through prayer, fasting and timely use of the Word of God, as we see in the temptation accounts of the Gospels of Matthew and Luke. And after 40 days in the desert He emerged, both poised and prepared to serve the people He would soon redeem.














Ancient Greek Mosaics
