From The Pastor

Behold the Lamb

Today we once again consider the figure of Saint John the Baptist. As we know, John was put to death by King Herod because he had the courage to witness to Christ and challenge the illicit lifestyle of the King. John's martyrdom was the crowning moment of a life that always pointed to the presence of Jesus Christ in the world.

We recall the Visitation of Mary to Elizabeth (cf. LK 1:39ff) when John leaps in his mother's womb, thus announcing to his own mother that Christ is present in Mary's womb!

Later, as an adult, John is called to radically proclaim the impending arrival of the Messiah. As the New Testament indicates, John preached a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. His mission was to prepare souls to encounter the Real Presence of the Lord. This is manifested so beautifully in today's Gospel reading when Jesus arrives in the presence of John the Baptist and immediately he cries out, "Behold the Lamb of God!" and two of John's disciples leave him and begin to follow Christ.

To me, the person of John the Baptist serves as a very clear model of what we as a Catholic parish should be about. Like John, our mission is to point people to Jesus Christ and witness to his presence in the world, in our Catholic Church and in our individual lives. Like John the Baptist, may our faith be strong enough to boldly preach the name and message Jesus to every person whom we encounter. And may the motto "Behold the Lamb of God" characterize the entire disposition of our parish, whose reason for being is to spread the Good News of Christ to everyone in our community.

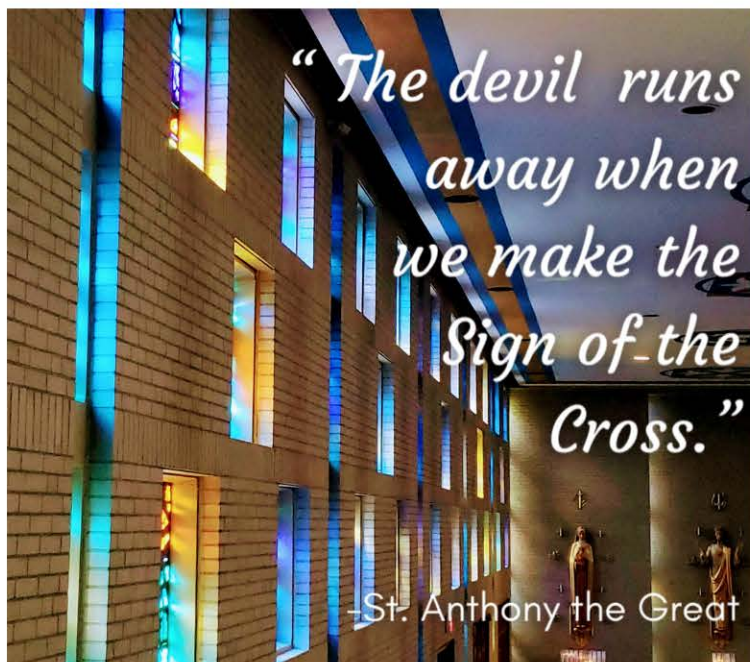
