From The Pastor

Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children



"Only with prayer—prayer that storms the heavens for justice and mercy, prayer that cleanses our hearts and souls—will the culture of death that surrounds us today be replaced with a culture of life."

*—U.S. Catholic Bishops,
Pastoral Plan for Pro-Life Activities*

The Catholic Bishops of the United States have designated tomorrow, January 22nd, as a special day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion.

On January 22, 1973, the Supreme Court legalized abortion throughout the United States in its companion decisions *Roe v. Wade* and *Doe v. Bolton*. Since that time, millions of children have lost their lives, and millions of women and families have been wounded by abortion.

Thankfully, on June 24, 2022, the *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization* decision overturned *Roe v. Wade*, and we praise God for the great opportunity state and federal legislators now have to protect pre-born children. While God, in His mercy, ended the nearly fifty-year nationwide regime of abortion on demand, right now state and federal laws, in many instances, are still hostile to pre-born children.

I encourage that we all observe tomorrow's Day of Prayer and Penance by performing some concrete act of mortification such as abstaining from meat, skipping a meal, giving up a favorite treat or activity, etc. Further, it would be of great benefit to attend Mass, pray a family Rosary or offer up some sort of special prayer for the unborn and for an end to abortion.

Respect Life Ministry

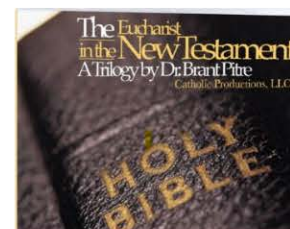
