From Fr. Richard

On Epiphany Sunday,

we celebrate the three kings from the east following a star to the Bethlehem stable to



adore the newborn king of the Jews. These royal astrologers, or magi, foretold by Isaiah hundreds of years earlier, brought gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh in tribute to the promised Messiah. The three kings represent those outside of God's Chosen People for whom salvation would now be forever opened. As we close the Christmas season this week, let us be mindful of the many ways God has blessed our lives through the grace of Jesus Christ.

I am especially grateful in this new year because of the 'epiphanies' in my own life. Later this week, I will celebrate my 70th birthday and, with it, begin my retirement from active priestly ministry. As Father Michael has explained in a previous bulletin, I will remain living on the St. Winifred's property and continue to help with Mass and Confessions, but on a limited basis. Also, my second book of religious fiction will be published by Lambing Press later in January. The title of this book is *Honeymoon and Other Pilgrimage Stories* and is about Catholic couples, families, friends, parishes, and schools on pilgrimage to various shrines across the United States. Once the book is available, I will begin a series of readings and book signings at parishes, coffee shops, and retreat centers in the diocese, including our own parish. This should also keep me active as I begin my retirement.

In his letter granting me permission to retire, Bishop David Zubik reminded me that retirement for a priest "is never intended as a retirement from priestly ministry". So, as long as the good Lord gives me strength, I will continue to help at St. Paul of the Cross Parish and South Hills Catholic Academy, but on a limited basis in accordance with my age and health.

I have been blessed with the fraternal friendship of Fr. Michael Caridi since our days in the seminary more than thirty-five years ago and our priestly service at two different parishes. His compassion and concern has enabled me to pace myself over the past year, or so, as I recuperated from a couple of heart operations. I look forward to our continued collaboration here at our parish and at the academy in ministry to the wonderful families we serve in the Priesthood of Jesus Christ.
