



From The Pastor



First Reconciliation

Over the next two days 76 students from our parish's CCD Program and South Hills Catholic Academy will receive the Sacrament of Penance for the first time. In doing so, they will be taking a final and most important step in their preparations to receive Holy Communion for the first time in early May.

In a real sense, the children making their first Reconciliation remind us during this season of Lent that each of us are unfortunately marked and affected by sin. WHAT IS VESPERS?


Vespers is the liturgy of evening prayer, one of the canonical hours of the Catholic Church. The word *vesper* translates to "evening" in Latin.

Our Vespers liturgy will be prayed in the context of a Holy Hour, which will include Adoration, chanted psalms and canticles, and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

WHY ATTEND VESPERS?

When we pray the Liturgy of the Hours, we are able to unite ourselves in prayer to Christ Himself. Attending and praying Vespers helps us to fulfill Jesus' command to "pray always" (Luke 18:1). In a special way, evening prayer helps us to express gratitude for the day that has passed and makes an evening sacrifice of praise to God.

The Liturgy of the Hours is like an extension of the Eucharistic celebration. Our Vespers liturgy will provide you with an additional opportunity for prayer as part of your Lenten sacrifice.


