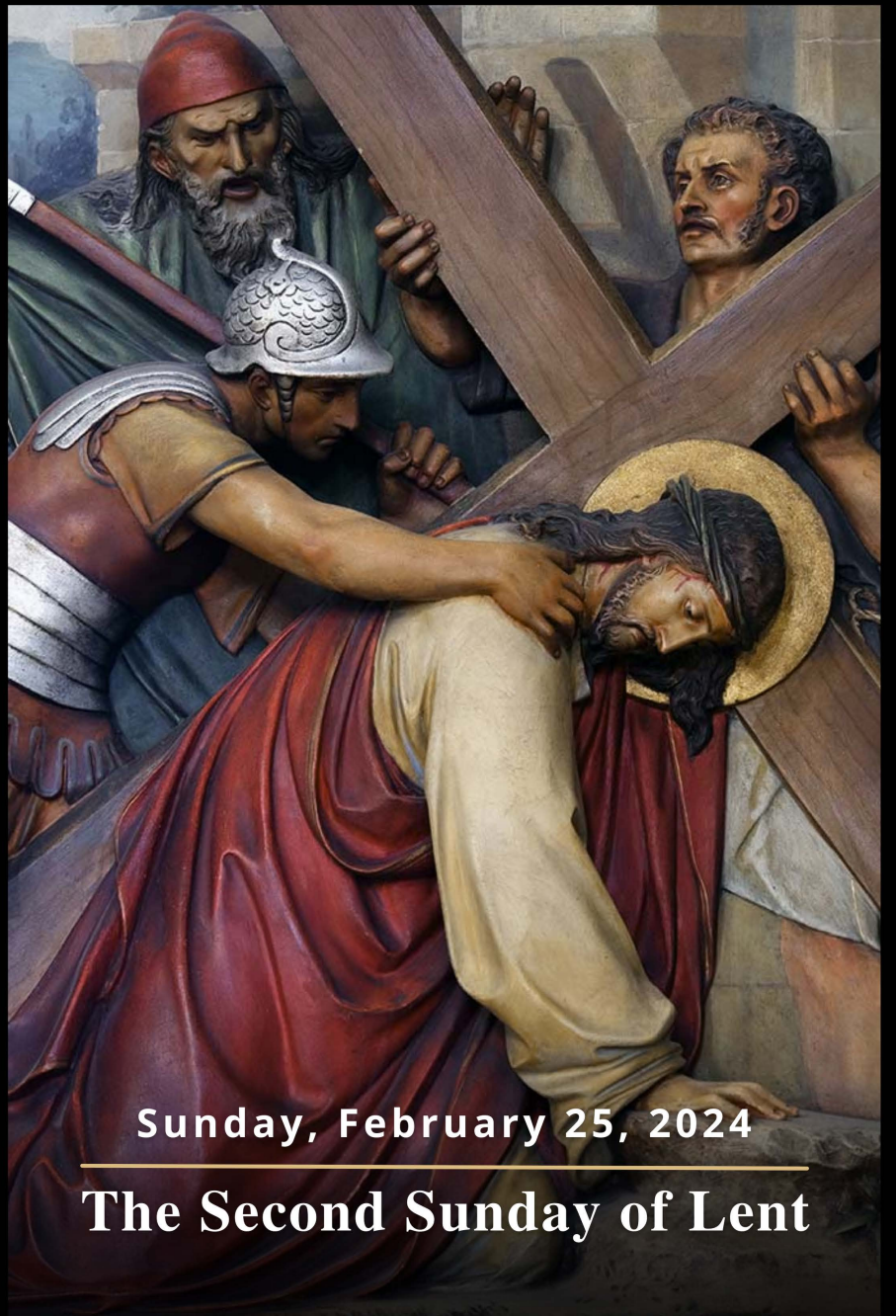

First Reconciliation

Over the next two days 76 students from our parish's CCD Program and South Hills Catholic Academy will receive the Sacrament of Penance for the first time. In doing so, they will be taking a final and most important step in their preparations to receive Holy Communion for the first time in early May.

In a real sense, the children making their first Reconciliation remind us during this season of Lent that each of us are unfortunately marked and affected by sin. Nevertheless, the loving forgiveness of Jesus Christ is always present and offered to us in a most profound way in the Sacrament of Confession, which Christ Himself instituted on Easter Sunday (see John 20:23) so that His ministry of mercy would be continued until the end of time.

WHAT IS VESPERS?

Vespers is the liturgy of evening prayer, one of the canonical hours of the Catholic Church. The word *vesper* translates to “evening” in Latin.

Our Vespers liturgy will be prayed in the context of a Holy Hour, which will include Adoration, chanted psalms and canticles, and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

WHY ATTEND VESPERS?

When we pray the Liturgy of the Hours, we are able to unite ourselves in prayer to Christ Himself. Attending and praying Vespers helps us to fulfill Jesus’ command to “pray always” (Luke 18:1). In a special way, evening prayer helps us to express gratitude for the day that has passed and makes an evening sacrifice of praise to God.

The Liturgy of the Hours is like an extension of the Eucharistic celebration. Our Vespers liturgy will provide you with an additional opportunity for prayer as part of your Lenten sacrifice.

Moving forward, here's how the Holy Hour will be structured:

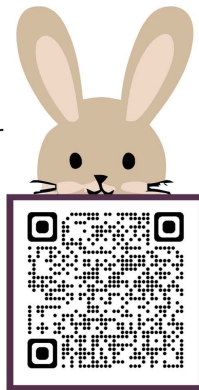
- 3:00 PM – Divine Mercy Chaplet offered before the Most Blessed Sacrament

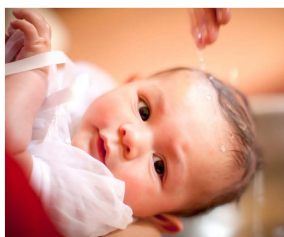

Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays after the 10:00 AM Mass at Saint Anne church. Call the parish office at (412) 531-5964 to schedule. Completion of a Pre-Baptism class is required with your

first child before scheduling. Our next Baptism class will be held on **March 12 at 5:00 PM** in the DePalma Room. If you have questions, or would like to register, contact Don Fontana at fontana@stpaulofthecross.com.

Confessions: At Saint Anne you may receive the sacrament on Tuesdays from 5:15 - 6:15 PM and Saturdays from 11:00 - 11:45 AM. You can visit Saint Winifred church where reconciliation is scheduled on Saturdays from 4:45 - 5:15 PM.

Holy Eucharist is usually celebrated for the first time around age seven or eight and is preceded by First Confession (the Sacrament of Reconciliation). If you have a child who is of age, and currently enrolled in a program please save these important dates:

- May 2, Mandatory First Holy Communion Practice, at 6:00 PM in St. Anne church
- May 5, First Holy Communion at Noon in St Anne

Confirmation will take place for those students who have completed their 8th grade catechesis. Time spent in catechesis and prayer is necessary for preparing for such a pivotal sacrament in the life of our teens. If you have a child who is of age, and currently enrolled in a Faith Formation (CCD) program, please save these important dates:

- May 2, Mandatory Confirmation Practice at 7:00 PM in St. Anne church
- May 4, Confirmation at 10:00 AM in St Anne church

For adults, Confirmation usually takes place as part of the Order of Christian Initiation for Adults (OCIA) and interested candidates should connect with the Parish Office to inquire.

Weddings are scheduled on Saturdays at 1:30 PM in Saint Anne church. Arrangements must be made with the parish priest at least six months in advance, and a Pre-Cana class is required. This class is scheduled for March 1 & 2 this year. Additional information about the class, including a link for registration, are available on our website in the *Sacraments and Ceremonies* section on in the ad on the previous page of this bulletin.
