

Make This Week "HOLY"

Because of Easter's early date this year, many of us may be unprepared for Holy Week.
Nevertheless, it's here and we find ourselves once again challenged to actively enter into the drama of Christ's passion, death and resurrection as it unfolds throughout the next seven days.

As Catholics, we are called upon to take this week very seriously and approach the upcoming holy days in a disciplined and meditative manner. As a parish, of course, we will offer the traditional and rich liturgies of the Church which help us to recall the events that brought about our salvation. However, we are also called upon to personally engage in this holiest of weeks through acts of personal penance, fasting and devotion.

Perhaps one way of observing the week would be to carve out some personal time to privately read over one of the accounts of our Lord's Sacred Passion and meditate upon the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Holy Rosary.

The scriptural accounts of the Passion can be found in Matthew 26-28; Mark 14-15; Luke 22-23; and John 18-19

Confessions:

Through the Sacrament of Penance we prepare our souls to receive the supernatural graces offered to us at Easter. Confessions will be heard at the following times:

- Tuesday: 5:15-6:15 PM in Saint Anne church
- Saturday: 11:00-11:45 AM in Saint Anne church

Holy Thursday:

On Holy Thursday the Church celebrates Christ's institution of the Sacraments of Holy Eucharist and Priesthood. Through our celebration of the Mass of the Lord's Supper and our Eucharistic Vigil we enter the Upper Room and Garden of Gethsemane with Jesus and His Apostles.


- No morning Mass on Holy Thursday
- The Mass of the Lord's Supper will be offered at 6:30 PM in Saint Anne church
- Saint Anne church will remain open until Midnight for quiet Eucharistic devotion

Good Friday:

When Jesus announced to His Apostles the He must now go to Jerusalem to be handed over, suffer and be crucified, Saint Thomas exclaimed: "Let us also go, that we might die with Him" (JN 11:16). Our devout observance of Good Friday will assist us in fulfilling this imperative of Thomas.

- There will be no Mass on Good Friday
- The church will be open all day for quiet prayer and devotion
- The Good Friday Liturgy will be offered at 1:30 PM
- We will begin a nine day Divine Mercy Novena at the end of the liturgy. This prayer will be repeated after the 6:30 PM stations as well.
- Stations and Veneration of the Cross will be offered at 6:30 PM
- Good Friday is a day of both fasting and abstinence

Divine Mercy Novena Starting Good Friday

Join the parish in St. Anne church as we begin a Divine Mercy Novena leading up to our celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday, April 7th. Our nine day prayer schedule is below. We hope to see everyone in person but, if you must miss a day, you can participate at home. The prayers can be found on our website. They consist of a short prayer for the day's intention and recitation of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, explained on the next page.

Day 1, Good Friday; We will pray the Divine Mercy Novena after the Good Friday 1:30PM Service and after Stations & Veneration of the Cross at 6:30 PM.

Day 2, Holy Saturday; We will pray the Divine Mercy Novena at 3:00 PM.

Day 3, Easter Sunday; Parishioners are encouraged to pray the Divine Mercy Novena at home with family this particular day since it's Easter Sunday.

Day 4, Easter Monday; We will pray the Divine Mercy Novena after the 8:00 AM Mass

Day 5, Easter Tuesday; We will pray the Divine Mercy Novena after the 8:00 AM Mass, at 3:00 PM during Adoration and after the 6:30 PM Mass.

Day 6, Easter Wednesday; We will pray the Divine Mercy Novena after the 8:00 AM Mass.

Day 7, Easter Thursday; We will pray the Divine Mercy Novena after the 8:00 AM Mass.

Day 8, Easter Friday; We will pray the Divine Mercy Novena after the 8:00 AM Mass.

Day 9, Easter Saturday; We will pray the Divine Mercy Novena after the 8:00 AM Mass, 4:00PM Mass and 5:30 PM mass. Last day of Novena specific prayers.



How to Recite the Chaplet of Divine Mercy

The Chaplet of Divine Mercy is recited using ordinary Rosary beads of five decades. During the Novena, the Chaplet will be preceded by a short prayer for the day's intention

- **1. Make the Sign of the Cross:** *In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.*
- **2. Opening Prayer:** You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.
 - (Repeat three times) O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You!
- **3. Our Father:** Our Father, Who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil, Amen.




- **5. The Apostles' Creed:** I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit, and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third day He rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the Communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen
- **6. On the "Our Father"** *bead before each decade* **pray:** *Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.*
- **7. On the "Hail Mary"** *beads of each decade* **pray**: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
- **8. Repeat** the prayers of Number 6 & 7, saying "Eternal Father" on the "Our Father" bead and then 10 "For the Sake of His Sorrowful Passion" on the following 10 "Hail Mary" beads four more decades.

9. At the conclusion of the five decades, pray (three times): *Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy mortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.*

10. Closing Prayer: Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless, and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us, and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments, we might not despair, nor become despondent, but with great confidence, submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy Itself. Amen

Our Lord said to Saint Faustina: (excerpt from her diary)

Encourage souls to say the Chaplet which I have given you ... Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death ... When they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as the just Judge but as the Merciful Savior ... Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation. Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy. I desire to grant unimaginable graces to those souls who trust in My mercy.... through the Chaplet you will obtain every thing, if what you ask for is compatible with My will (687, 1541, 1731).
