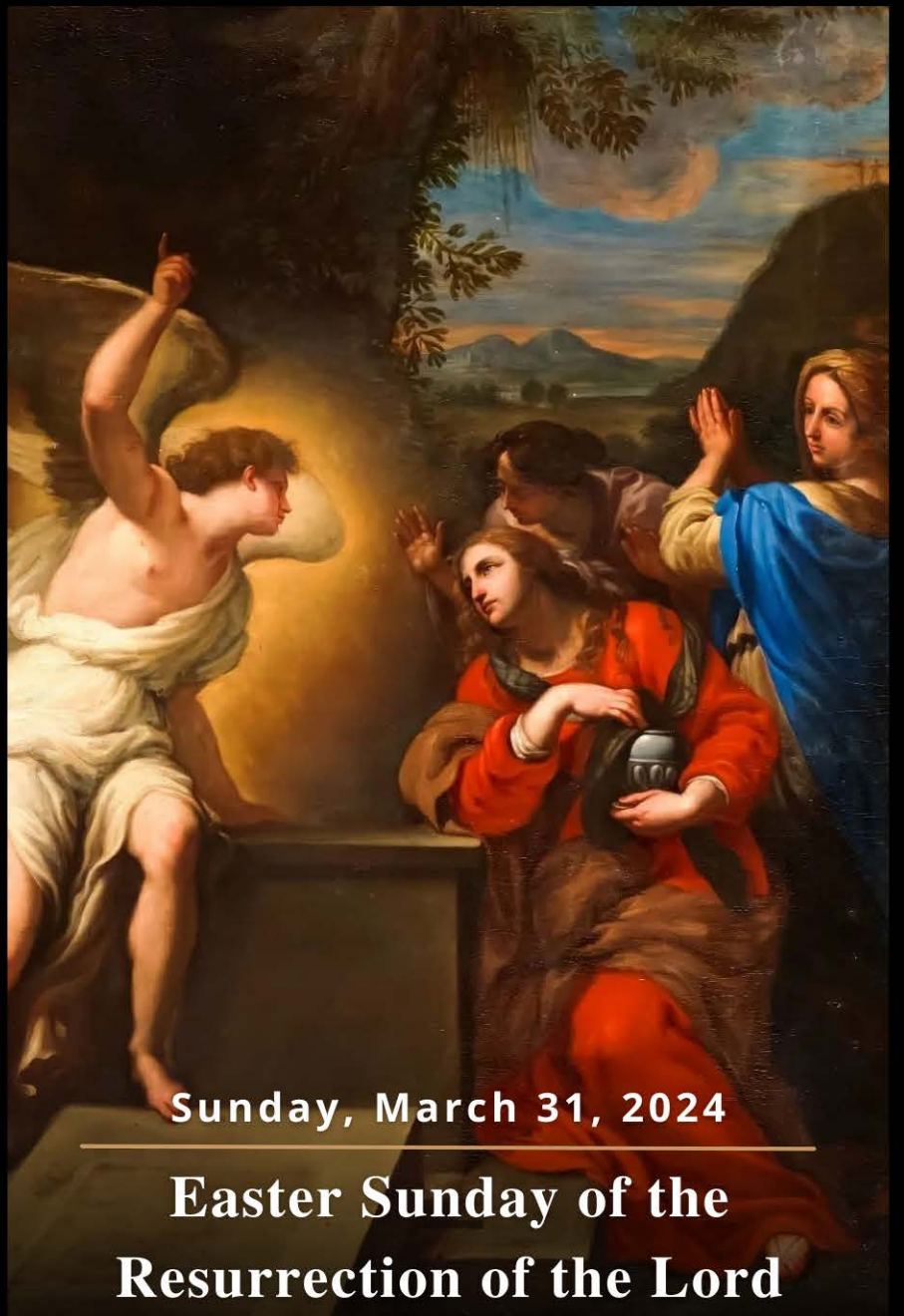

Dear Parishioners,

We finally begin our celebration of Easter!

In professing our belief in the Resurrection of Christ, we are essentially proclaiming that God has the power to transform seemingly impossible situations, and can indeed bring good out of evil, light out of darkness, joy out of sadness, and life out of death.

This Easter, God wants to transform you and me as well. And He wants to accomplish this by uniting us to the Body of His Resurrected and Glorified Son through our reception of the Easter Sacraments.

Today, as we celebrate our Lord's passage from a lifeless corpse that filled his followers with dread, shame and sorrow to a glorified Body that elicited awe and joy from those who encountered Him, let us not be afraid to confront those parts of our lives that are lifeless, old and defeated. What, deep down, are we ashamed of? What do we need to turn over to Christ before it's too late? How do we need to change?

Ultimately, we celebrate Easter because we believe that this sort of change is indeed possible. Therefore, let us resolve on this glorious day to live closer to Jesus every day, so that someone somewhere can soon say about us, what was proclaimed about him on that first Easter Sunday: "He is no longer here, He has been raised!" (MK 16:6)





Divine Mercy Novena Continues

The remainder of our nine day prayer schedule is below. We hope to see everyone in person but, if you must miss a day, you can participate at home. The prayers can be found on our website. They consist of a short prayer for the day's intention and recitation of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, explained on the next page.

Day 3, March 31st, Easter Sunday; Parishioners are encouraged to pray the Divine Mercy Novena at home with family this particular day since it's Easter Sunday.

Day 4, April 1st, Easter Monday; We will pray the Divine Mercy Novena after the 8:00 AM Mass

Day 5, April 2nd, Easter Tuesday; We will pray the Divine Mercy Novena after the 8:00 AM Mass, at 3:00 PM during Adoration and after the 6:30 PM Mass.

Day 6, April 3rd, Easter Wednesday; We will pray the Divine Mercy Novena after the 8:00 AM Mass.

Day 7, April 4th, Easter Thursday; We will pray the Divine Mercy Novena after the 8:00 AM Mass.

Day 8, April 5th, Easter Friday; We will pray the Divine Mercy Novena after the 8:00 AM Mass.

Day 9, April 6th, Easter Saturday; We will pray the Divine Mercy Novena after the 8:00 AM Mass, 4:00PM Mass and 5:30 PM mass. Last day of Novena specific prayers.

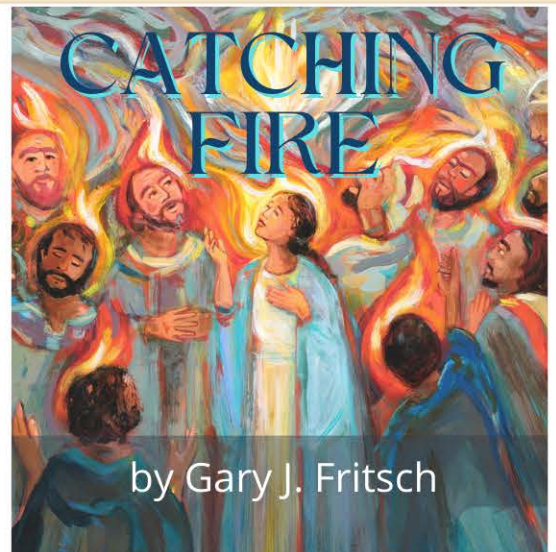

Catching Fire: Relating the Ancient to the Everyday.

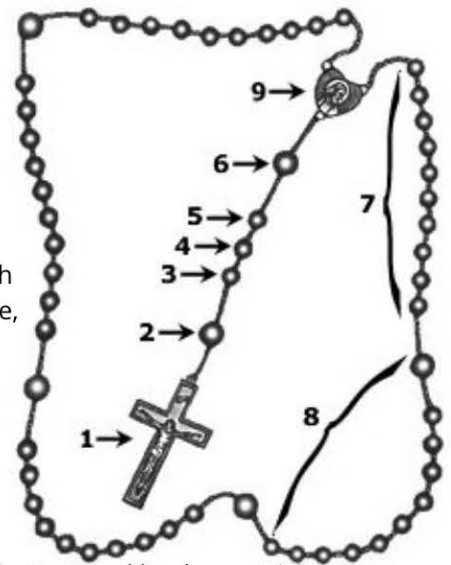
From Easter until Pentecost, Jesus opens the minds of the Apostles to the scriptures - all in the light of the Resurrection, **which changes everything**. When ignited by the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, these truths were so powerful, that they transformed a group of men cowering in an upper room into bold and unstoppable beacons of the Love of God through Jesus Christ. They were Catching Fire. Join Gary Fritsch as he unpacks these life-changing truths from Scripture with inspiration, story and humor relevant to every person's life, and sure to ignite a spark in your life of faith.



How to Recite the Chaplet of Divine Mercy

The Chaplet of Divine Mercy is recited using ordinary Rosary beads of five decades. During the Novena, the Chaplet will be preceded by a short prayer for the day's intention

- 1. Make the Sign of the Cross:** In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
- 2. Optional Opening Prayer:** You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.
(Repeat three times) O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You!
- 3. Our Father:** Our Father, Who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil, Amen.
- 4. Hail Mary:** Hail Mary, full of grace. The Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou amongst women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death, Amen.
- 5. The Apostles' Creed:** I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit, and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third day He rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the Communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen
- 6. On the "Our Father" bead before each decade pray:** Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.
- 7. On the "Hail Mary" beads of each decade pray:** For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
- 8. Repeat** the prayers of Number 6 & 7, saying "Eternal Father" on the "Our Father" bead and then 10 "For the Sake of His Sorrowful Passion" on the following 10 "Hail Mary" beads four more decades.
- At the conclusion of the five decades, **on the medallion** pray (three times): Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy mortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
- 10. Closing Prayer** (optional): Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless, and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us, and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments, we might not despair, nor become despondent, but with great confidence, submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy Itself. Amen



Our Lord said to Saint Faustina: *(excerpt from her diary)*

Encourage souls to say the Chaplet which I have given you ... Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death ... When they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as the just Judge but as the Merciful Savior ... Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation. Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy. I desire to grant unimaginable graces to those souls who trust in My mercy.... through the Chaplet you will obtain every thing, if what you ask for is compatible with My will (687, 1541, 1731).

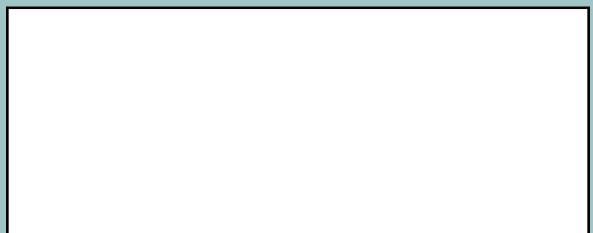
