

# From the Pastor



# Pertecost Surday and a new Bishop too!

Today we observe Pentecost, the day the Holy Spirit descended on the Apostles and what we consider to be the "Birthday of the Church". In essence, Pentecost is a feast of mission, unity and the outpouring of divine grace – and the perfect day to also celebrate the news that Pope Leo XIV has appointed Bishop Mark Eckman as the next Bishop of the Diocese of Pittsburgh.


Bishop Eckman is a son of our diocese, and a well-regarded priest who has ministered for decades with humility, dedication and pastoral care. He grew up and has served in many South Hills parishes, including Saint Winifred, Saint Sylvester, and Saint Thomas More.

Our parish has a special place in the Bishop's heart, because as a youngster his family would often attend Saint Anne's for Mass; and he once told me that he would regularly fixate on the wall of angels behind the main altar and count how many angels there are. So it's good to know that in some small way our parish played a role in nourishing the seeds of his vocation. Without a doubt, his appointment is a moment of pride for the Catholics in the South Hills, as one of our own is now called to shepherd the entire diocese.

Just as the Holy Spirit came upon the Apostles at the first Pentecost to send them forth in mission, so too is Bishop Eckman being called upon to serve the Church in a new and challenging way. In Catholic teaching, a bishop is a successor of the Apostles, entrusted with the fullness of the Sacrament of Holy Orders. He is the chief teacher, sanctifier and shepherd of the local Church, called upon to guard

the faith, celebrate the Sacraments, and lead God's people in charity and truth.

So let us pray that the same Holy Spirit who came upon the Church that first Pentecost will animate our new bishop with wisdom, strength and joy as he embraces his new charge.




