From the Pastor



Holy Eucharist: The Gift that Remains

This weekend the Church celebrates the great Solemnity of Corpus Christi, lifting up with joy and reverence the central mystery of our Catholic faith: that Jesus Christ remains with us always – Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity – in the Holy Eucharist.

In conjunction with this Feast, we are hosting our annual 40 Hours Devotion, a time-honored tradition that deepens our love for Jesus and the Holy Eucharist through extended time in prayer and adoration before the Blessed Sacrament. Please see the complete schedule for the Forty Hours on this page. Please see the complete schedule for the Forty Hours to the right, and carve out some time to show our Lord that you appreciate Who He is, and what He's done for us!

The 40 Hours devotion originated in 16th century Italy during a period of social unrest and deep spiritual need. As a remedy, Catholics were invited to adore Christ in the Eucharist for forty hours in honor of the forty hours He laid in the tomb, and recalling the forty days of preparation so often found in Sacred Scripture.

On Monday evening at 6:30pm, I encourage you to also participate in the Solemn Closing Mass of 40 the Hours. This will also mark my final Mass here as your pastor, and I can think of no more meaningful a way to conclude my time with you than by gathering around the altar, worshipping Christ truly present in the Eucharist, and together offering *the* Sacrifice of Thanksgiving.

For every priest, the Eucharist is the heart of our priestly lives, Day in and day out, in good times and in bad, the Blessed Sacrament is our strength, our purpose, our joy - indeed our reason for being! And so while parting is never easy, as I go forth to assume a new assignment, I find solace in the truth that I leave with you the same Jesus Who never leaves. In every tabernacle, and through every Mass, He remains. And that, dear friends, is the greatest treasure of our faith.

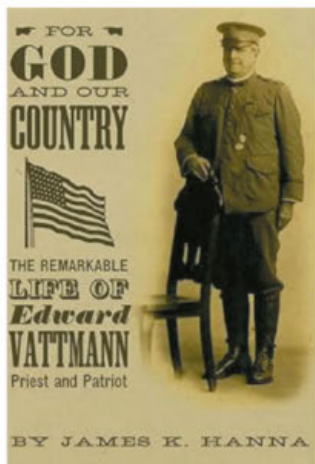

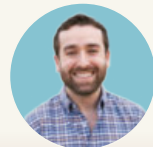
