

first child before scheduling. Our next Baptism class will be held **July 8**th **from 5:30-7:00 PM** in the DePalma Room. If you have questions, or would like to register, contact Don Fontana at dfontana@stpaulofthecross.com.


Confessions: At Saint Anne you may receive the sacrament on Tuesdays from 5:15 - 6:15 PM and Saturdays from 11:00 - 11:45 AM. You can visit Saint Winifred church where Reconciliation is scheduled on Saturdays from 4:45 - 5:15 PM.

Holy Eucharist is usually celebrated for the first time around age seven or eight and is preceded by First Confession (the Sacrament of Reconciliation). If you have a child who is of age, be sure to enroll them in our Faith Formation (CCD) program at South Hills Catholic Academy. Enrollment for the 2025/26 school year will open in July. Search "CCD" on our parish website or call (412) 631- 3131 for more information.

Weddings are scheduled on Saturdays at 1:30 PM in Saint Anne church. Arrangements must be made with the parish priest at least six months in advance, and a Pre-Cana class is required. This class takes place each year on the first weekend of March. Information about the class, as well as guidelines regarding wedding planning in our parish, is available on our website in the

Confirmation takes place in the spring of 8th grade. All home-schooled, public and parochial school students who have not been confirmed should be enrolled in our Faith Formation (CCD) program at South Hills Catholic Academy. Time spent in catechesis and prayer is necessary for preparing for such a pivotal sacrament in the life of our teens. Be sure to enroll them in our Faith Formation (CCD) program at South Hills Catholic Academy. Enrollment for the 2025/26 school year will open in July. Search "CCD" on our parish website or call (412) 631- 3131 for more information.

For adults, Confirmation usually takes place as part of the Order of Christian Initiation for Adults (OCIA) and interested candidates should connect with the Parish Office to inquire.

Christian Rite of Burial

Funerals are *usually* scheduled Monday-Saturday at Saint Anne Church at 9:30 AM and most often coordinated by a funeral home director. Our sacristans will guide you through the planning of the Mass. In extraordinary circumstances, arrangements for a Blessing Service can alternately be made. All Catholics must make appropriate arrangements to be permanently interred in a cemetery or a Catholic funeral cannot be offered.

Sacramental Information

Routinely, requests come to the parish office that have to be denied, because those making the requests are innocently and unknowingly asking for something the Catholic Church cannot provide or does not allow. Those conflicts are described below, in a straightforward way, so as to clear up any confusion:



Baptism



Confirmation



Marriage

GODPARENTS: Several parents registering their children for Baptism have asked to have godparents who do not meet the requirements because: A) They are not fully initiated Catholics (having received Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion; or B) Because their marriage is not recognized as a valid Sacrament (i.e. blessed by the Church), and therefore the proposed godparent is ineligible to receive the Sacraments themselves, and thus cannot be held up as a role model for the child being baptized.

In order to serve as a godparent an individual must be a practicing Catholic, registered in a Catholic parish, have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Communion and Confirmation, and, if married, the marriage must be recognized as a "valid Sacrament" by the Catholic Church.

These are norms provided by the Catholic Church and we are duty bound to adhere to them. To ask someone to serve as a godparent and role model of the Catholic faith who simply cannot fulfill that role is unfair to that individual and to the child who is to be baptized.

SPONSOR LETTERS: Many requests are received to provide a Sponsor letter when a parishioner has been asked to serve a Godparent for Baptism or Sponsor for Confirmation.

In order to receive a Sponsor letter the following is required:

- A) Must be registered in our parish (having attended school or CCD here decades ago does not necessarily mean one is registered).
- B) Must be Baptized, received First Eucharist and Confirmation.
- C) If Married, the Marriage must be a valid Sacramental Marriage (i.e. recognized and blessed by the Catholic Church).

MARRIAGE: Many people don't realize that a Baptized Catholic is required to be married in the Catholic Church in a Catholic ceremony with rare exception. To be married by a Justice of the Peace or on a beach or even in another non-Catholic church WITHOUT the proper dispensation renders one's marriage invalid in the eyes of the Church. This has serious ramifications as to whether one can serve as a Godparent, Confirmation Sponsor, or even receive the Sacraments themselves moving forward.

If you have any doubts as to whether or not you are in a valid Catholic Marriage or would like to pursue having your Marriage blessed by the Church, please call the parish office.

LOST CERTIFICATES: Our parish office cannot reissue misplaced certificates for sacraments received before 2019 (when the merger took place). For an official replacement, contact the Archives and Records Center of the Diocese of Pittsburgh online at *diopitt.org/archives* or call (421) 456 - 3158. The archives hold all of the Sacramental records for the former Saint Anne and Saint Winifred Parishes.


