From the Pastor

Dear brothers and sisters,

Thank you for welcoming me to St. Paul of the Cross Parish. I am honored and excited to journey with you in faith and service. Firstly, I would like to extend a word of thanks to Fr. Caridi for his help during our transition and to the parish staff for getting me up and running. I have already been able to meet some of you, the faithful, and I am looking forward to getting to know our parish family at large.

To help you become more familiar with me, I will share a brief vocation story. Both of my parents were raised in Carnegie and their families were members of two of the five ethnic parishes at the time. Those parishes were merged in the early 1990's and formed St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish. There, they raised my sister, brother and I as active members of the parish. My siblings and I were sent to the parish elementary school and would later attend Carlynton School District after the closure of the parish school.

As I progressed through school, I became more involved with the regular life of my home parish. It was at the parish school, serving Sunday Mass, funerals and weddings, and volunteering at spaghetti dinners, festivals, bingos and fish fries, that I felt the Lord uncovering a desire in my heart. That desire was for joy! The joy of working, sharing, and growing together and the person who exuded the most joy was the priest, who was visibly present at those activities.

That desire never really went away as I worked through public high school. As a result, I sought the advice of my home pastor and with his help, approached the Diocese about discerning a priestly vocation. I was accepted into the seminary formation program following my high school graduation. I lived at St. Paul Seminary and earned a bachelor's degree in Philosophy from Duquesne University. During this time, I actually spent two summers

helping out at (what is now) Blessed Trinity Parish, our neighbor's on the other side of Rt. 51.

After completing my undergraduate work, Bishop Zubik assigned me to St. Vincent Seminary in Latrobe. There, under the tutelage of the Benedictine community, I worked, studied, and prayed (a lot) to prepare myself for whatever kind of the work the Lord would call me to do. Though, privately, I still longed for the joy I found in the midst of my parish family. While not yet finished at St. Vincent, I was assigned to Our Lady of the Valley Parish, Beaver County, where I served as a seminarian and transitional Deacon.

I was ordained to the priesthood by Bishop Zubik on June 26, 2021. My first priestly assignment was at St. Andrew the Apostle Parish in the Mid Mon Valley where I served for two years. I was then called to serve as parochial vicar at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Parish in the North Hills. So from the Beaver Valley, to the Mid Mon Valley, the North Hill to the South Hills, I am happy to be here in my home neck of the lovely South Hills of Pittsburgh.

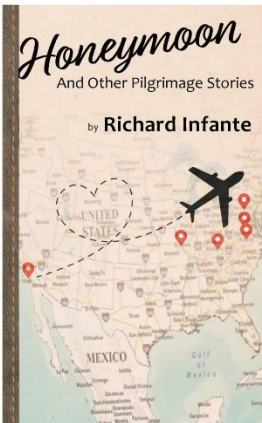

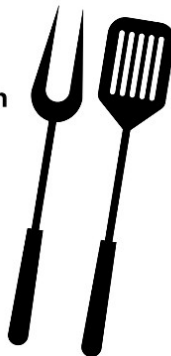

Confessions: At Saint Anne Church you may receive the sacrament on Tuesdays from 5:15 - 6:15 PM and Saturdays from 11:00 - 11:45 AM. You can visit Saint Winifred Church where the sacrament is scheduled on Saturdays from 4:45 - 5:15 PM.

Holy Eucharist is usually celebrated for the first time around age seven or eight and is preceded by First Confession (the Sacrament of Reconciliation). If you have a child who is of age, be sure to enroll them in our Faith Formation (CCD) program at South Hills Catholic Academy. **Enrollment for the 2025/26 school year has opened.** Search "CCD" on our parish website or call (412) 631- 3131 for more information.

This class takes place each year on the first weekend of March. 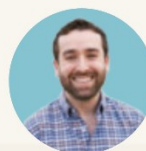

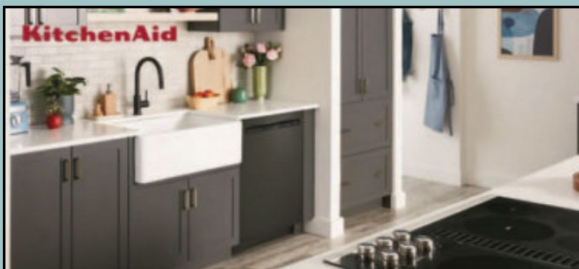
