This week, from the Gospel of St. Luke, Jesus says "For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be." The treasure He desires for us is faith, hope and trust in the Father who has loved us into being. This is what He came to teach His disciples and through them the faithful of His Church. However, this teaching comes with a call to action. In the verse before, Jesus says "provide moneybags for yourselves that do not wear out." We need to make room for what the Lord desires us to hold as treasure. Our work is to store up and put to good use the faith we have received. From the Letter to the Hebrew's we read, "Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen." Faith that is lived out without reservation is the realization of what is hoped for, eternal life in God's Kingdom!






