The disciples remarked how where they were gathered was deserted and with only five loaves and two fish, they must've thought they were going to fall short of the Lord's commands. *Bring them here to me*. In this action, Jesus shows us that even with a little, even in a deserted place, going to him is the answer. What is the result? All ate and were filled, with twelve wicker baskets of fragments remaining. A superabundant feast, that nourished not only the body, but the soul. We are given this great gift in the Eucharist. Having received our Lord in this Blessed Sacrament, how might we *give some food ourselves* and nourish those we meet with the presence of Christ?

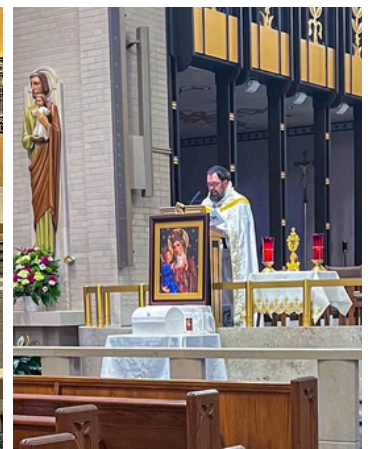

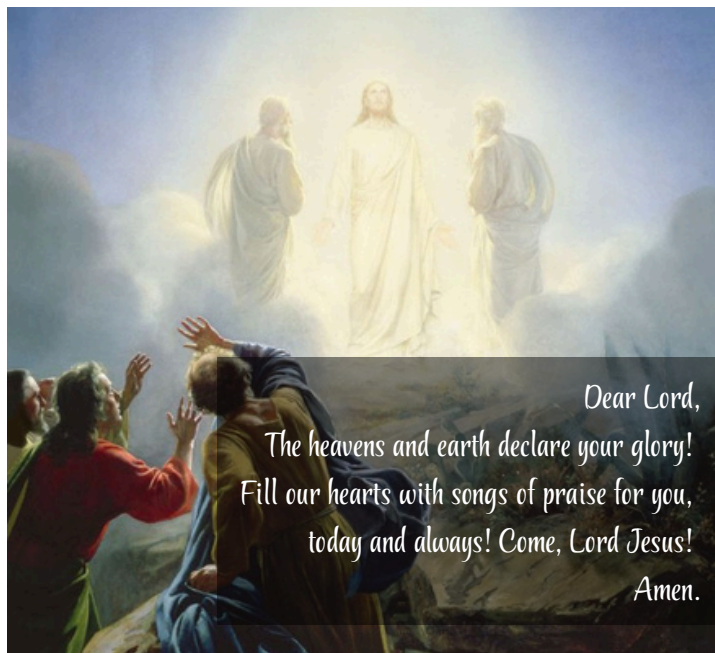
