





# Sacramental Information



**Baptisms** are celebrated on Sundays after the 10:00 AM Mass at Saint Anne Church. Call the parish office at (412) 531-5964 to schedule. Completion of a Pre-Baptism class is **required** with your first child before

scheduling. Our next Baptism class will be held March 17<sup>th</sup> from 5:30 - 7:00 PM in the DePalma Room. If you have questions, or would like to register, contact Don Fontana at [dfontana@stpaulofthecross.com](mailto:dfontana@stpaulofthecross.com).

**Confessions:** At Saint Anne Church you may receive the sacrament on Tuesdays from 5:15 - 6:15 PM and Saturdays from 11:00 - 11:45 AM. You can visit Saint Winifred Church where the sacrament is scheduled on Saturdays from 4:45 - 5:15 PM.

**Holy Eucharist** is usually celebrated for the first time around age seven or eight and is preceded by First Confession (the Sacrament of Reconciliation). If you have a child who is of age, be sure to enroll them in our Faith Formation (CCD) program at South Hills Catholic Academy. Enrollment for the 2025/26 school year has opened. More information can be found in the *Faith Formation K-8* section on our website or by calling (412) 631- 3131.



**Confirmation** takes place in the spring of 8th grade. All home-schooled, public and parochial school students who are of age and desire to be confirmed should enroll in our Faith Formation (CCD) program at South Hills Catholic Academy. More information can be found in the *Faith Formation K-8* section on our website or by calling South Hills Catholic Academy at (412) 631- 3131.

For adults, Confirmation usually takes place as part of the Order of Christian Initiation for Adults (OCIA) and interested candidates should connect with the Parish Office to inquire.

**Weddings** are scheduled on Saturdays at 1:30 PM in Saint Anne Church. Arrangements must be made with the parish priest at least twelve months in advance and before any other bookings are made. A marriage preparation (Pre-Cana) class is **required**. This class takes place each year on the first weekend of March. Information about the class, as well as guidelines regarding wedding planning in our parish, is available on our website in the *Sacraments and Ceremonies* section.

If you or someone you know has recently become engaged to be married, they are invited to contact Fr. Joe Uzar to set up an appointment to meet with him. Call the parish office at (412) 531-5964.

Our sacristans will guide you through the planning of the Mass. In extraordinary circumstances, arrangements for a funeral outside of Mass can alternately be made. All Catholics must make appropriate arrangements to be permanently interred in a cemetery or a Catholic funeral cannot be offered.
