PLEASE NOTE: There is an additional, important update on the following page. Below is my weekly reflection and an update on our interim music ministry program.

Thomas said to him, "Master, we do not know where you are going, how can we know the way?"

I have often found great comfort in this question from St. Thomas the Apostle. There is a great trust yet a feeling of uncertainty in Thomas when Jesus says, "Where I am going, you know the way." In those moments when we experience uncertainty or anxiety for the future, we are like St. Thomas. Jesus' consoling answer is one we all should listen to. He is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. To the Parish Community of St. Paul of the Cross

On July 1, 2025, I began my new assignment as Pastor of St. Paul of the Cross Parish. Over the last ten months I have enjoyed learning about the rich customs and traditions of the parish and, more importantly, coming to know so many wonderful parishioners. I have also spent much time in prayer and reflection, considering how we can continue to grow together as a community of faith.

One of my greatest hopes is to build an environment where every individual from our youngest members to our seasoned seniors feels a profound sense of belonging and spiritual accompaniment.

To ensure the parish is meeting the spiritual and sacramental needs of all our members, I have determined that our parish would greatly benefit from the addition of two vital pastoral staff positions.

I recently informed the Clergy Team, Parish Staff, and Advisory Councils of my decision to reorganize our staff to focus on lifelong discipleship. To that end, we will be advertising for two new parish staff positions:

- **Pastoral Associate:** This position will provide strategic leadership, supervision, and spiritual mentorship to the Faith Formation and Evangelization efforts within the parish. This leader will oversee the broad spiritual and communal life of the parish, ensuring that our parish provides pastoral care for all our members.
- **Director of Faith Formation:** Working with the Pastoral Associate, the Director will design and implement catechetical and formation programs for children and families with children in grades K-8. The Director will also recruit, train, develop and oversee catechists and support staff.

To meet our staffing goals and fill these new positions, I am realigning the Safe Environment and Adult Faith Formation Coordinator role. Additionally, I will be concluding our faith formation agreement with South Hills Catholic Academy. I want to thank Mrs. Harmony Stewart, Director of the program, and all those catechists who have faithfully served in this capacity for the last five years.

Moving forward, I envision a parish that purposefully invites every parishioner into our common life, ensuring our young families, in particular, feel seen, valued, and essential to our future. While I recognize that change can be challenging, I am confident that realigning our resources will empower every parishioner to grow as a missionary disciple.

Please know that I am happy to address any questions you may have and welcome your feedback. During this time of transition and new opportunity, I humbly ask for your prayers support, and patience.

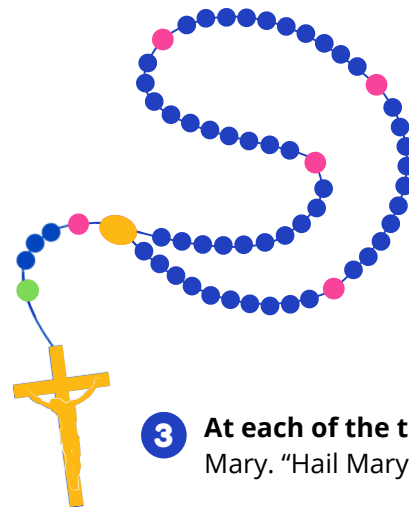

- 1 At the crucifix** make the Sign of the Cross. Then pray the Apostle's Creed, a summary of what we believe. "I believe in God, The Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth..."
- 2 On the first large bead** pray an Our Father, the prayer that Jesus taught us. "Our Father, who art in heaven..."
- 3 At each of the three smaller beads** pray the Hail Mary. "Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee..."
- 4 At the next large bead** pray the Glory Be. "Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit..."

- 5 At the medal** say the first mystery and pray an Our Father.
- 6 At the group of ten beads that follows** pray one Hail Mary for each bead.
- 7 At the second large bead** pray the Glory Be, announce the next mystery, and pray an Our Father. Pray a Hail Mary for each of the beads in the next decade. **Repeat** this simple pattern for each of the remaining decades.

Conclude by making the Sign of the Cross.

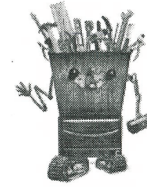
