

From the Pastor

Holy Week 2023

Today we enter into the holiest week of the Church's liturgical calendar. In taking up palms we are reminded that each of us has an active role to play as the drama of Christ's passion, death and resurrection unfolds throughout the next seven days. I encourage everyone to make this a truly holy week through increased acts of penance, fasting and prayerful devotion. Please plan on attending the solemn liturgies of Holy Week which recall and make present the redemption Christ won for you and me.

"These, then, are days which speak to us **powerfully** of God's *love and mercy*" - Pope Francis

Confessions:

Many supernatural graces are available during this Holy Week. Through the Sacrament of Penance we prepare our souls to receive them. Confessions will be heard at the following times:

- Monday: 6:00 PM in Saint Anne church (with several local priests assisting)
- Saturday 11:00 AM 11:45 AM in Saint Anne church

Holy Thursday:

After his triumphal entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, Jesus instructed his Apostles to make preparations for the traditional Jewish Passover meal. During the meal – His Last Supper – Jesus institutes the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist, whereby we personally receive His Body and Blood and share in the fruits of His redemptive sacrifice. The Mass of Holy Thursday recalls the institution of this Sacrament of Love as well as the Sacrament of the Priesthood, and challenges us not only to receive the sacrificial love of Christ, but to share it with others.

- There will be no morning Mass on Holy Thursday. The Chrism Mass will be offered by Bishop Zubik at Saint Paul Cathedral at 10:00 AM.
- The Mass of the Lord's Supper will be offered in Saint Anne church at 6:30 PM.
- Both Saint Anne and Saint Winifred churches will remain open until 12:00 midnight for quiet Eucharistic devotion.

Good Friday:

Earlier, Jesus had told his Apostles that they were going to Jerusalem where he would be handed over, made to suffer and be put to death. The words of the Apostle Thomas are words that we might have on our own lips as we observe our Lord's Sacred Passion: "Let us also go, that we might die with Him" (JN 11:16).

- There will be no Mass on Good Friday
- The main Good Friday Liturgy is scheduled for 1:30 PM IN SAINT ANNE CHURCH
- Stations and Veneration of the Cross will be offered at 6:30 PM IN SAINT WINIFRED CHURCH
- Good Friday is a day of fasting and abstinence

Holy Week

Holy Saturday:

The Easter Vigil Mass is a rich liturgical moment through which we are drawn into Christ's victory over sin, darkness and death. Beginning in total darkness – which symbolizes the cold reality of sin and death – the Easter Vigil is a powerful ceremony which conveys the ability of the Risen Christ to bring light to the world through the Easter Sacraments. During the Easter Vigil, the Sacraments of the Church will be offered for the first time to those RCIA candidates converting to the Catholic faith.

- Confessions will be heard from 11:00 AM 11:45 AM
- Easter Baskets will be blessed at 12:30 PM
- The Easter vigil Mass will begin at 8:30 PM

Easter Sunday:

This is the day we've been preparing for throughout the season of Lent. As we have committed with God's help to overcome the darkness of sin, today we rejoice that the Paschal Mystery of Christ has stripped away whatever may keep us from God. As we renew our baptismal promises at Easter Sunday Mass, may Christ's resurrection inspire us to live more faithful lives of joyous Christian service!

Easter Sunday Masses will be offered at the following times:

- Saint Anne church: 8:00 AM, 10:00 AM, and 6:00 PM.
- Saint Winifred church: 11:30 AM

Veneration of the Cross

Adoration or veneration of an image or representation of Christ's cross does not mean that we actually adore the material image, of course, but rather what it represents. In kneeling before the crucifix and kissing it we are paying the highest honor to our Lord's cross as the instrument of our salvation. Because the Cross is inseparable from His sacrifice, in reverencing His Cross we, in effect, adore Christ. Thus we affirm: 'We adore Thee, O Christ, and we bless Thee because by Thy Holy Cross Thou has Redeemed the World.'

Thank you all for your support and participation in the Disciple Maker Index Survey (DMI) through Catholic Leadership Institute (CLI). As you know, Bishop Zubik is focused on fortifying our parishes for the work of evangelization and to grow as

missionary disciples so that all people will come to Learn, Love and Live Jesus. Our work with CLI is just one small piece of Bishop Zubik's greater vision. The hope is that all parishioners will grow in their

faith and develop a deeper relationship with Jesus to begin to share the Good News of Jesus Christ with others.

Since the DMI Survey closed on March 31st, parishes will now begin the important task of assessing the results. This spring, CLI will provide all parishes with assistance in interpreting the results of the DMI and analyzing the data. All final paper surveys will be sent to CLI for data entry and inclusion in the final parish report.

Over the course of the next three to four years, all parishes in the diocese will be involved in pastoral planning. The results of the DMI Survey will help parishes create a pastoral plan that is centered on evangelization and growing in discipleship. The pastoral plan, which will focus on three strategic priorities, will enable our parish to shift our focus from "maintenance-driven" to "mission-driven" action. All of this planning will help us grow our parish for the future and align all of our parish activity with mission and ministry.


