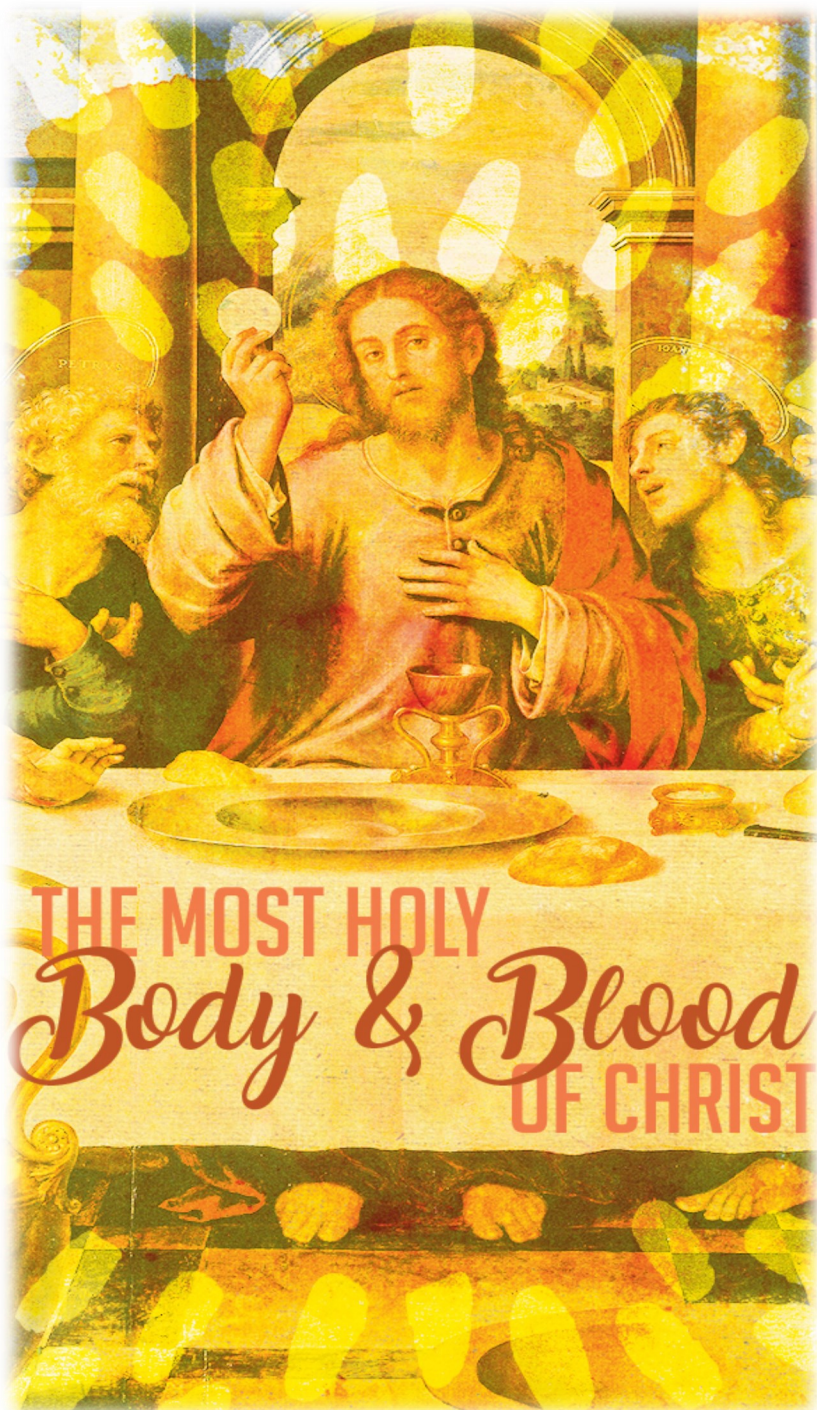

FROM THE PASTOR

O Sacrament Most Holy

Today is the Solemnity of Corpus Christi (the *Body and Blood of Christ*). On this Feast Day the Church wishes to hold up for our contemplation and devotion the central mystery of our Catholic faith: the Real Presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist, sacrificed daily on our altar and perpetually present in the tabernacle.

As Catholics, we see in the Eucharist the concrete fulfillment of Christ's promise to be with His Church until the end of time. Therefore, the Blessed Sacrament is a sign that our Lord has not abandoned us; that He is always with us, sharing in our joys and sorrows, accompanying us on our journey to the Kingdom of Heaven.

Today's Feast Day affords us the opportunity to renew our devotion to the Real Presence by receiving Holy Communion with greater reverence, committing to attend Eucharistic Adoration with greater frequency and by concretely expressing in some appropriate manner our belief and trust that Jesus is with us in the Most Blessed Sacrament of the Altar.

So, as we observe this special feast day, let us examine our disposition before the Eucharist. Does the Sunday celebration of Mass and the reception of Holy Communion occupy *the* central part of our lives? Do we receive Communion in the requisite state of grace, having gone to Confession beforehand, if necessary? Is Jesus the focal point of our lives and is this concretely expressed through our reverential disposition towards the Mass and the Most Blessed Sacrament of the Altar?

MISSION SUNDAY

This weekend, Fr. Jilson George will be joining us for Mission Sunday and preaching about his work in the Diocese of Mandya in India.

The Diocese of Mandya strives to evangelize through pastoral care and concern for youth and students, promoting the priesthood and vocations to religious life, providing clinical care in dispensaries, and providing services to community centers throughout the region.
