



FROM THE DESK OF FATHER MIKE ...

SAINT PAUL OF THE CROSS PARISH

As anticipated, on Friday, May 17, Bishop Zubik signed a decree merging St. Anne and St. Winifred parishes into the new St. Paul of the Cross Parish, effective Monday, July 1. You can read the decree on our parish website and a letter from the Bishop is included in today's bulletin.

The formation of the new parish is the culmination of the Bishop's "On Mission" initiative meant to address changing demographics in the Church, the decline in priestly vocations and marshal resources to better serve the people. It is important to note that while our parish will have a new name—St. Paul of the Cross each church will retain the name under which it was consecrated. Therefore, St. Paul of the Cross will be one parish with two churches, St. Anne and St. Winifred! St. Anne School will also retain its name.

Why "St. Paul of the Cross"?

St. Paul of the Cross (1694-1775), born Paul Danei in northern Italy, experienced a conversion to a life of prayer at age 19. Influenced by the writings of St. Francis de Sales, it became Paul's lifelong conviction that God is most easily encountered and understood in the Passion of Jesus Christ.

When Paul was 26 he had an experience making it clear to him that God was inviting him to form a religious order that would promote the love of God revealed in the Passion of Christ. At age 33 he was ordained a Catholic priest and in due time established the community that came to be known as the Congregation of the Passion, or the Passionists.

The first Passionists to arrive in America were brought to Pittsburgh by Bishop Michael O'Connor in 1852. They originally staffed St. Michael Parish on the Southside and built St. Paul of the Cross Monastery and Retreat Center where many of our parishioners make their annual retreat, even today!

In 1892 the Passionists were invited by the Opferman Family to celebrate monthly Mass in their home in what is now Bethel Park, and four years later, as a result of their pastoral care, it was the Passionists who established the first Catholic parish in the South Hills, St. Anne's. As the population continued to grow, several other parishes were formed out of St. Anne's including St. Winifred's in 1960. Therefore, the Bishop's naming St. Paul of the Cross as our patron is a tribute to the firm foundation of faith the Passionists established in our community.

It is my hope and prayer that we will embrace the positives: our new parish will be bigger, it will be able to finance more ministries and initiatives, and we will have an additional patron saint, Paul of the Cross, whose example reminds us of what is most important; namely, that consumed by love for us, Jesus Christ suffered and died so that we can gain paradise. Essentially, the mission of our new parish will be to proclaim and make present this awesome and beautiful reality.
